Weekend Parking October: The 1st Street Lot by the Riverfront is \$10 cash only – in and out privileges for the day and includes \$1 tickets for Spooks Shuttle to specific uptown activities like Seek the Spirit of Halloween Coin Challenge. A \$2 dollar per person savings. This parking lot is the closest to all activities unless specified. Enter from Old Portland.

Weekend parking through 9 p.m. except during music events. Gates are locked at within a half hour of any final performance. You will be towed prior to gates being locked. Call Drakes Towing at (503) 438-6099 to retrieve your car.

Driving Directions from Portland

Drive west on US-Highway 30 from Portland towards St. Helens.

Preferred Route

- Head west on US-Hwy 30
- Turn **RIGHT** onto Gable Road
- Turn slightly left to continue onto Old Portland Rd
- Turn **RIGHT** onto Plymouth Street
- Follow this road until a dead-end

Alternative Route

- Head west on US-Hwy 30
- Turn **RIGHT** onto Bennett Road
- Turn **LEFT** on Old Portland Road
- When the road comes to a "T", turn **RIGHT** to continue on Old Portland Rd
- Turn **RIGHT** onto Plymouth Street
- Follow this road until a dead-end

Parking Information:

There is very little parking available in St. Helens. It is recommended that you park in the Main Lot, denoted by red star (451 S. 6th Street). This is closest to all activities and restrooms. Available weekends only. During the week, there is street parking available.

Parking is \$10/day with in & out privileges. Cash only. Parking Pass Includes Deep Discount on Spooks Shuttle for entire car.

ADA Parking Area & Restrooms is within this area and accessible for all. You may enter this area anytime from either the paid parking lot or during weekdays. Restrooms are also right by parking area for ADA Accessible. This parking area is approximately 2 short city blocks to the center of the activities Courthouse Plaza.

Bathrooms: There are a few different groups of facilities. One across from City Hall. Portable options include one near Riverfront Parking Exit off Strand Street. Others are around town in general merchant areas. Behind the Cotton Candy Booth and Near the Tractor Rides.
