Driving Directions from Portland

Drive west on US-Highway 30 from Portland towards St. Helens.

Preferred Route

- Head west on US-Hwy 30
- Turn RIGHT onto Gable Road
- Turn slightly left to continue onto Old Portland Rd
- Turn RIGHT onto Plymouth Street
- Follow this road until a dead-end

Alternative Route

- Head west on US-Hwy 30
- Turn RIGHT onto Bennett Road
- Turn LEFT on Old Portland Road
- When the road comes to a "T", turn RIGHT to continue on Old Portland Rd
- Turn RIGHT onto Plymouth Street
- Follow this road until a dead-end

Parking Information:

There is very little parking available in St. Helens. It is recommended that you park in the Main Lot, denoted by red star (451 S. 6th Street). This is closest to all activities and restrooms. Available weekends only. During the week, there is street parking available.

Parking is \$10/day with in & out privileges. Cash only. Parking Pass Includes Deep Discount on Spooks Shuttle for entire car.

When parking please do not block others and do not park on pathways within the parking area. Please see our map for driving instructions on discovercolumbiacounty.com No overnight parking.

ADA Parking Area & Restrooms is within this area and accessible for all. You may enter this area anytime from either the paid parking lot or during weekdays. Restrooms are also right by parking area for ADA Accessible. This parking area is approximately 2 short city blocks to the center of the activities Courthouse Plaza.

Weekday parking through 9 p.m. except during music events on October 7th. Gates are locked at 9:30 p.m. and you will be towed prior to gates being locked. Call Drakes Towing at (503) 438-6099 to retrieve your car. The 1st Street Lot by Dockside Restaurant is available to park at no charge. This parking lot is the closest one to all activities unless specified. Type 343 S 1st Street, St. Helens, OR 97051 into your map for the entrance to this parking location. Access via Columbia Blvd or Old Portland Road. When parking please do not block others and do not park on pathways within the parking area.

Bathrooms: There are 3 different groups of facilities. One across from City Hall. Portable options include one near Riverfront Parking Exit off Strand Street, and another near The Klondike Restaurant.

St. Helens is a small town and you will more than likely need to drive to attend events unless you take the shuttle from the corner of Courthouse Plaza. Park in the paid downtown lot on weekends which includes spooks shuttle passes for just \$1 per person on weekends. Regular weekend rates \$3 per person on Spooks Shuttle and \$1 on weekdays per person. No charge in the parking lot at the end of 1st Street on week days (503) 438-6099. No parking in this area after 9 p.m. on weekdays or you will be towed. Please call Drake Towing to retrieve your vehicle. Gates are locked at 9 p.m.

1. Get your shuttle ticket \$3 cash only at The Spooks Shuttle Stop at the corner of the Courthouse Plaza Square – Cash Only.
2. Board the “Spooks Shuttle” and receive your participation card. If you need assistance and are unable to ride the shuttle which is not ADA accessible you may still get your card from the driver at the shuttle stop.

3. Find the Spirit of Halloweentown “Square” at the participating local stores listed on your card. Complete your card.
4. Take the Spooks Shuttle back to the Courthouse Plaza. Shuttle pickup is at The Chronicle Newspaper building on the corner of Columbia Blvd and South 18th Street.
5. At your leisure (maybe when leaving town), return your card to Skinny’s Texaco (373 S. Columbia River Hwy) and receive a special Spirit of Halloweentown commemorative coin. Fill up with at least 8 gallons of gas for your ride home and you will also receive a free soda from the soda machine.

Spooks Shuttle Weekend Ticket Package: For those that park in the official Spirit of Halloweentown paid parking lot on weekends, spook shuttle tickets are just \$1 per person. Parking attendants will give you the shuttle discount cards. Regular tickets are \$3 per person on weekends and \$2 per person Monday - Friday.
